\$75 Demand Response (DR) Technology Incentive

SCE offers a one-time DR Technology Incentive of \$75 to customers who purchase a qualifying thermostat and enroll in a DR program through an Authorized 3rd Party participating in the California Independent System Operator's (CAISO) Demand Response Auction Mechanism (DRAM). The DR Technology Incentive is provided to SCE customers in the form of a bill credit. The following conditions apply:

- Customers will need to supply a proof of purchase for the qualifying thermostat showing that it was purchased on or after January 1, 2018.
- If your service account closes or you disenroll from the DRAM program before SCE can process any portion of the DR Technology Incentive, your DR Technology Incentive will be cancelled.
- The DR Technology Incentive is limited to one per service account and will not exceed \$75. Purchasing and installing multiple smart thermostats for the same account will not increase your incentive amount.
- This rebate amount cannot exceed the actual cost of the thermostat.
- Customers who have more than one service account (e.g., a second home) and purchase a qualifying smart thermostat may be eligible for more than one DR Technology Incentive.
- SCE will not provide a DR Technology Incentive for a thermostat that SCE has already previously paid for. This includes payment to any previous owner of the thermostat through this or any other DR program offering a smart thermostat rebate, incentive or credit. SCE will monitor this by thermostat serial number.
- Customers who received their thermostat from an SCE program (e.g., the residential direct install program) are not eligible for the \$75 DR Technology Incentive.
- Bill credits can be processed within one to two billing cycles.
- Tenants are responsible for obtaining the property owner's permission to install the product for which they are applying for a rebate. The signature on this application indicates "permission" was obtained.
- Customers may not receive a rebate for the same product from more than one California investor-owned utility or third-party energy efficiency/demand response program offering rebates, financing, or other incentives funded with CPUC Public Goods Charge funds.
- This offer is funded by SCE customers and administered by SCE under the auspices of the California Public Utilities Commission. Funds are available on a first-come, first-served basis until such funds are no longer available. This offer may be modified or terminated without prior notice.

Consent to Temperature Adjustments from SCE or Authorized DR Service Providers

Customers who apply for and are approved to receive the \$75 DR Technology Incentive agree to allow SCE or their other Authorized Third Party DR Service Provider to remotely adjust the temperature setpoint on the thermostat, without dependence on manual customer intervention, to minimize A/C usage during energy events for qualifying DR programs. This capability to remotely adjust the temperature setpoint on eligible thermostats is contingent on the DR Service Provider establishing a relationship with thermostat manufacturers or thermostat service providers that can connect to the thermostat. To enable this feature, SCE or Authorized Third Party DR Service Provider may share the customer name, service address, email address, thermostat model name and serial number with an authorized thermostat manufacturer or thermostat service provider. SCE or Authorized Third Party DR Service Provider should not ask customers for their thermostat account log in credentials and password established with their thermostat manufacturer. The term of consent applies throughout the effective useful life of the thermostat, which is up to 11 years, while the thermostat model and serial number are active under the same service account.

Customers can override the temperature adjustment at any time during an event utilizing the standard adjustment methods offered by their thermostat manufacturer (e.g., mobile app, website, manually). Customers may revoke their consent to have their thermostat remotely adjusted during energy events by contacting SCE at (800) 736-4777 or emailing massmarketDRsupport@sce.com.

The Qualifying DR programs that may utilize the smart thermostat temperature adjustment feature are Smart Energy Program, Critical Peak Pricing (CPP), Capacity Bidding Program (CBP) and DR Programs offered through the Demand Response Auction Mechanism (DRAM). SCE reserves the right to add additional DR programs to the list of qualifying DR programs.
